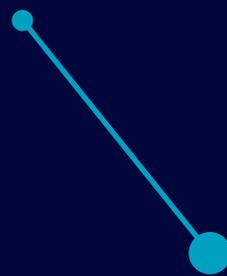

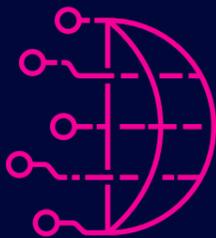

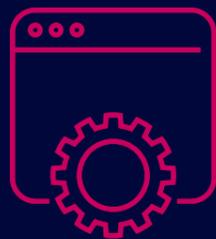

How does it work?



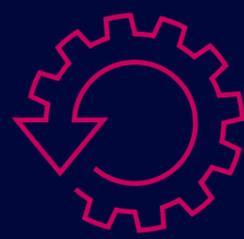
Initial training:

Intensive, practical, accredited training provided by Capita to get you up to speed.



Assignments:

Two years of on-site (at a Capita or a Capita client site) supported engagements and continued professional development with mentoring and training.



Post-programme:

After the first two years you can continue to work for Capita as an IT professional or you may have the opportunity to join your client organisation.

Your training

Based in either Manchester or London, your initial training is industry-level, comprehensive and includes both practical and theory-based elements. We bring together a wealth of experience from the Capita Group, as well as accreditation from technology houses and BCS, The Chartered Institute for IT. Although you may find our training intense, you're sure to find the practical applications exciting and

you'll be assigned a coach from day one to support you through every step of the way.

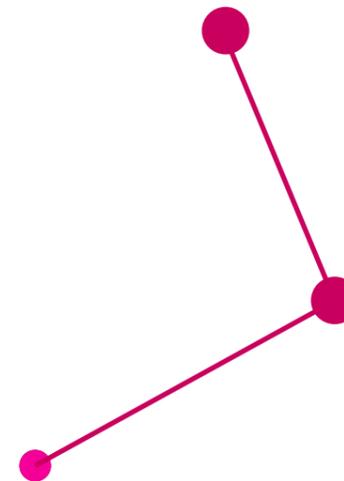

Assignments

Our training streams



Software Developer

As a software developer, you'll engage in identifying, designing, installing, testing, maintaining and updating a software system for a company from the ground up. You'll work closely with developers, product managers, graphic designers and business analysts to find out what clients want and the most efficient way to achieve this.

Our initial training will cover a number of programme languages, techniques and technologies. You'll gain industry-recognised professional certifications and gain hands-on practical experience.



Software Tester

Software testing involves the analysis of software and systems to avert risk and prevent issues. You'll be involved in the quality assurance stage of software development and deployment, conducting automated and manual tests to ensure that software is fit for purpose.

We'll train you in the methodologies and techniques of software testing, and offer you exposure to the necessary technical languages. You'll develop cross functional skills which will support your development.



Business Analyst

As a business analyst, you'll work within an organisation, helping to manage business change and plan for the future in line with their goals. You'll play a key role in communicating between internal and external parties, to help convey how information technology can support the organisation's needs.

You'll gain exposure to the extensive range of business analysis tools and techniques and work with the organisation to design the latest innovative business solutions. The programme gives you the opportunity to obtain a number of certifications as you work towards completing the BCS International Diploma in Business Analysis.



Project Support Officer

As project support officer, you'll be responsible for completing project work according to the plan and reporting progress to senior managers. You'll help to identify project risks, analyse critical paths, manage and delegate stakeholder tasks, as well as formulate and publish key project reports.

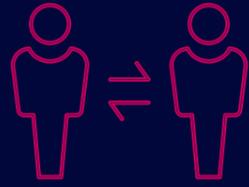

This programme could be ideal for you if you're:

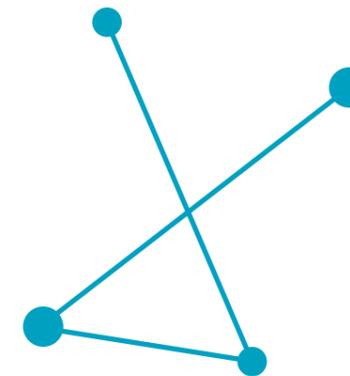
- Passionate about technology and want to become an IT professional
